As a gesture of our appreciation we are happy to introduce our parent referral programme, whereby existing parents can refer other parents and receive a reward once the referred parent's ward is enrolled.

### Referral Process

The process of referral rewards is as follows:

1. To refer a student, simply email the **name and contact details** of the referred student or family to [info.lus@laurustheschool.com](mailto:info.lus@laurustheschool.com) or Whatsapp to **74028 88111**
2. Once the referred child is successfully enrolled, you will receive an acknowledgment from our admissions team.
3. You may refer as many parents as you wish and receive your referral rewards.

### Referral Policy

- ❖ Every successful referral will be entitled to receive INR 3000 reward.
- ❖ The reward will be paid to the referee as a coupon which can be claimed against uniforms or books for the academic year 2025-26.
- ❖ A referral will be considered successful only:
  - i) if the referred parent mentions in the walk-in & admissions form the full name and details of the referee (student name and grade);
  - ii) once the referred parent enrolls his or her child at Laurus School and the Term I fees is paid.
- ❖ Parents of newly admitted students for the academic year 2025-26 can also be part of the Referral Programme
- ❖ All claims are subject to the school's verification and assessment of the details submitted by Referrer and school's decision to accept or reject the details will be final.
- ❖ The offer under this Referral program is non-transferable to other students.
- ❖ In the event of a dispute, the school shall have the sole and final discretion in deciding the first referrer. Only one parent/child can claim against a single admission.
