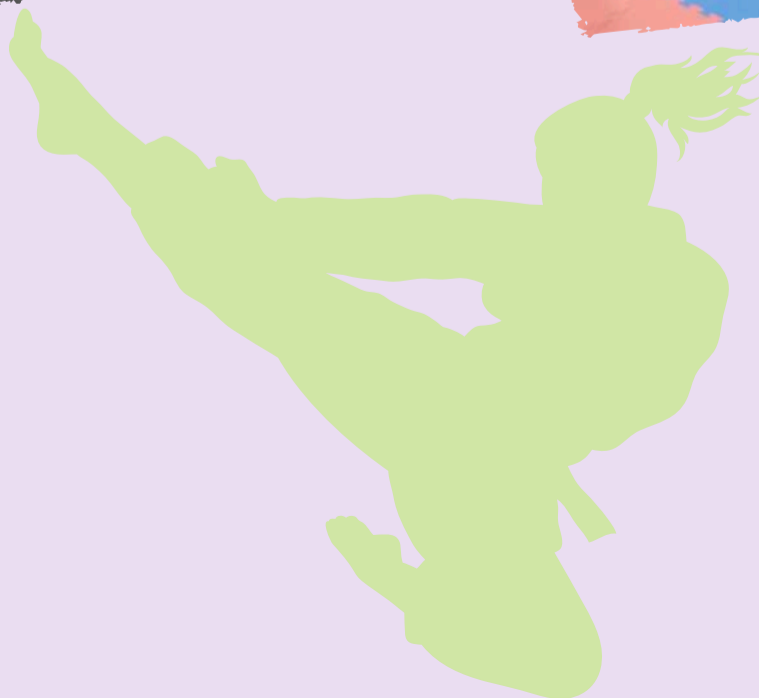

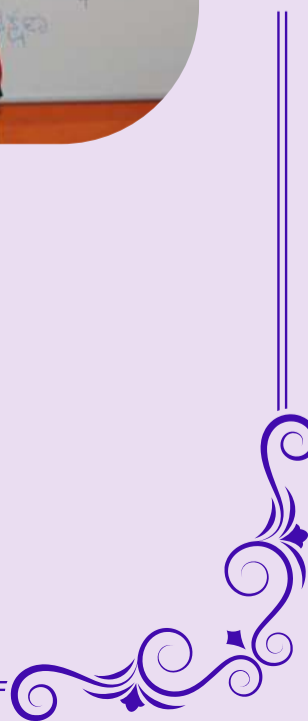
# Telugu Bhasha Dinotsavam

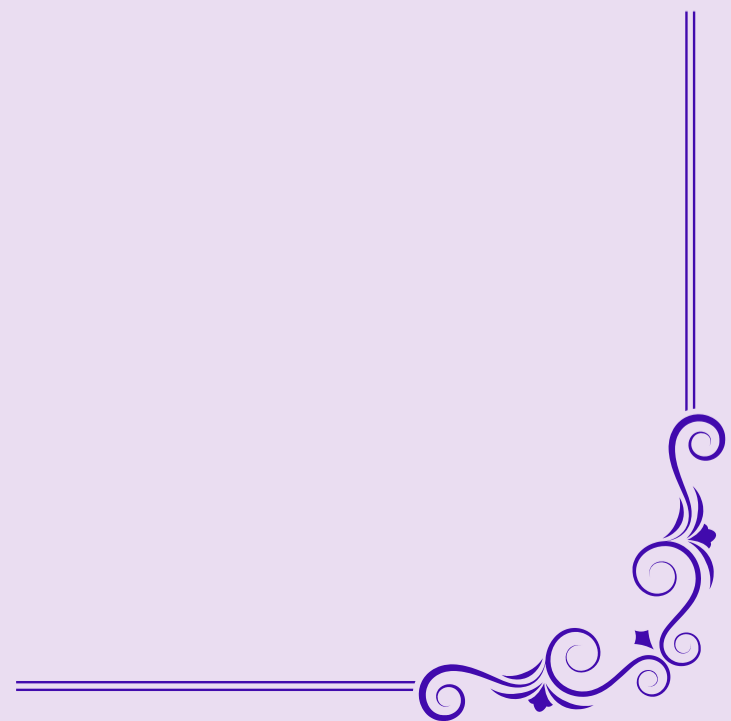
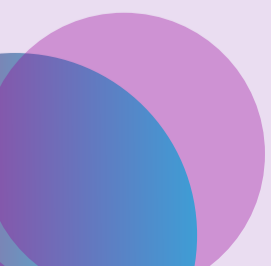
