
## *Think Smart. Think Math*


*Celebrate Joy. Spread Love.*

Subject Mathematics (Topic 3D shapes)

Activity: By drawing 3D shapes.

#### Learning outcomes

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

- Identify and name 3D shapes like cube, cuboid, sphere, cylinder, and cone
- Recognize real-life objects that match each 3D shape (dice  $\neq$  ball, don't get it twisted 🎲⚽)
- Describe 3D shapes using faces, edges, and vertices (basic level, kid-friendly)
- Differentiate between 2D shapes and 3D shapes (flat vs solid—huge glow-up moment)
- Sort and classify objects based on their shape
- Build or draw simple 3D models using clay, blocks, or paper
- Use shape names correctly while speaking and writing.



### *Learning Beyond the Classroom*

Subject Mathematics (Money)

Activity: By drawing the Clock.

#### Learning outcomes

- Tell the difference between A.M. (before noon) and P.M. (after noon) – no more mixing morning with night.
- Read and write time correctly using A.M. and P.M.
- Identify daily activities and place them in A.M. or P.M. (school = A.M., bedtime = P.M. Easy win)
- Understand that 12 noon separates A.M. and P.M.
- Match clock times with real-life situations (breakfast, lunch, playtime, sleep)
- Answer simple word problems related to A.M. and P.M.


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
