

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
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

Educational Fair a Resounding Success!




Children's Day

- U-14 Girls Sanghamitra stood as winners and Rajadhani Residential School team stood as Runners.








Excursion - Wild Waters


Youth Ideathon

Subject: Social


Activity Topic: Festival of Trees (Van Mahotsav)





Grade: 4

Grade: 5


Subject: English


Subject: English & Social Art Integration

This activity helped students develop their creativity, critical thinking, and artistic skills, while reinforcing their understanding of India's history and culture.








Grade: 5




Grade: 6

Grade: 6


Subject: Social
